

Duke's only serious threat was erased by a Seminole double play, when Pete Maynard singled with one down in the seventh, went to second on an error by McCarron, and Bristol walked Lon Bonczek. George Atkinson bounced into a double play to end the threat, though.

HUNT GETS TWO

Like Bristol, Burton conceded just four hits, two to Tribe third sacker Hunt. The crafty Duke southpaw walked nobody and fanned eight in losing his first game of the season.

In the afternoon battle, Michigan State exploded for 10 runs in the bottom of the fifth to vault past Yale, 19-9, and chalk up their second win of the tournament.

The Spartans sent 15 men to the plate against Stu Miller and Bruce Irving of Yale, and the key blow of the eight hits in the inning was a bases-loaded triple by center fielder Dick McKenzie.

Sophomore Bob Rabias, who made his first college appearance Monday night against Florida State, went all the way to chalk up the win for the Spartans, and hit a home run with none on to further his cause, in the second inning.

SOME ERRORS

Only four of the nine Yale runs were earned, as the Spartans made five errors behind Rabias, while 12 of the 19 Michigan State runs were earned, Yale making five mistakes.

McKenzie was the big stickler for the winners, closing a 3-4 double and triple and driving across five runs. Shortstop Jerry Korwek also had three hits, and three runs.
