

Florida State hoped to keep its baseball record clean this afternoon in a test against Big Ten representative Ohio State.

The Seminoles, who smacked Georgia, 10-1, yesterday, and the Buckeyes were set for a 3:30 p.m. game at Seminole Field. Ohio State and Georgia met in the first game of the double header at 12:30.

DAVIS SHINES

Timely hitting and nifty pitching by junior ace Frank Davis carried the Tribe to the nine-run decision over Georgia's debuting Bulldogs. It was the third victory for FSU, which topped Miami twice earlier in the week.

Davis checked the Bulldogs with three hits and no runs over eight innings. Sophomore Ray McShane worked the ninth, and surrendered Georgia's only run when he walked Wayne Exely with the bases loaded. Davis gained credit for his second 1960 victory.

Second baseman Ray Bazzell, centerfielder Jimmy White, and rightfielder Bob Clem paced a 13-hit FSU attack—with three hits each. The trio drove in seven runs.

DULL HOMERS

Third baseman Jack Dull of Tallahassee, who hit six home runs last season, belted a 360-foot home run over the right-center fence with the bases empty.

FSU took a 2-0 lead in the second on a walk, an error, and singles by Bazzell and shortstop Ernie Lanford. Catcher Bill Westendick's single, an infield out, and Bazzell's single to center made it 3-0 in the fourth.

A walk, an error, and singles by Lanford, Bazzell, and White produced three more runs in the sixth inning. Dull's homer made it 7-0 in the seventh and three more FSU runs scored in the eighth on doubles by White and Clem.

A scheduled game between Georgia and Ohio State earlier yesterday was cancelled when the Buckeyes' equipment failed to arrive in time.
