


Al Beccaccio has to be one of the real surprises of Florida State's young baseball season.



Not that the 195-pound senior from Newburgh, N. Y., hasn't had success before, because last season he was a regular second baseman with the Seminoles when they finished third in the College

Al Beccaccio World Series. He hit .298 in 25 games.

But Beccaccio rates the surprise tag for the way he's made the switch from infielder to pitcher.

Yielding only nine hits, Beccaccio weathered a ninth-inning rally yesterday at Seminole Field to stop Clemson, 10-7, and gain his second win in as many starts.

Only three of the Clemson runs were earned. In the opener against Auburn last weekend, Beccaccio allowed only one earned run while going the nine-inning route.

The two teams were to meet again here today. Saturday, there will be a tripleheader at Seminole Field involving Navy, Clemson and FSU. The first game, at 10 a.m., will pit Clemson and FSU; the second, at 12:30, brings Navy and Clemson together, and FSU meets Navy at 3 p.m. to wind it up.

In yesterday's game, FSU broke away early with three runs in the third and five in the fourth. FSU batters could get only eight hits, but five Clemson errors eased the way to victory.

Clemson scored four in the ninth on two walks, a hit batsman, two errors and two hits.
