

Second-inning homers by Jim Reed and Woody Woodward paved the way for a 9-2 Florida State baseball victory over Furman here Saturday afternoon as converted infielder Al Beccaccio pushed his pitching record to a glittering 5-0.

The win made FSU's record 10-3 for the season, with Valdosta State due in town Tuesday for a 5:30 p. m. single game before the Seminoles head through the Carolinas on a week-long excursion taking in such powers as Duke and Wake Forest.

The Seminoles wasted no time, routing Furman starter Ralph Harwood in the second inning. Harwood could get only one man out before reliever John McCormick could douse the fire, but McCormick was too late.

Totals for the second frame: seven Seminole runs on eight hits and one base on balls. Key licks were Reed's three-run homer and a two-bagger by Woodward—the latter's second in two days.

All told, FSU rapped out 12 hits, including another homer by Mike Augustine and a double by George Rountree.

Beccaccio, the team's regular

second baseman most of last year, gave up seven singles and no earned runs over seven innings before he stepped aside to give infielder Dave Dahlen a crack at mound work.

Leading hitters for FSU besides those mentioned above were Bill Williamson with three hits in three trips and Larry Johnson with two bingles in three appearances.

Only Paladins with more than one hit were Phil King and Tom Rhoads with two apiece. FSU helped itself defensively with three double plays involving the slick duo of Shortstop Woodward and Second Baseman Reed.
