

Junkman Marty Howell kept North Carolina batters off balance for nine innings while his mates clobbered three Tar Heel pitchers for 14 hits to win his third game of the season, 9-0, at Seminole Field yesterday.

The senior southpaw was never in trouble, giving up only four hits and walking only one batter. It was the Seminoles' second shutout of the young season. Cliff Ranew turned the trick against Georgia Tech, Monday.

Led by catcher Ken Suarez, Seminole hitters had a field day. Suarez scored a perfect three for three including one double, and drove in two runs. All American Mike Augustine broke out of an early season slump with two hits in four trips including a resounding triple which carried to the right center field fence.

Every man in the FSU lineup hit safely at least once, except Gerry Chmielewski and he scored Gary Nichols in the seventh with a long fly to center.

Georgia Tech won its second game of the year, squeezing by NE Louisiana, 3-2 in a game cut to seven innings by rain. Larry Zimmer and Larre Entekin singled home the winning runs in the sixth inning.

Four games were scheduled for today as the Florida State Invitational Tournament moved into its fifth day. North Carolina - Mississippi State and Duke - Amherst went at 11:30 this morning, followed by FSU - Mississippi State and Amherst - NE Louisiana at 3:30.

A full slate of action is also scheduled for tomorrow with FSU - Amherst and FSU - Duke at 11:30 and 3:30 on Seminole Field, and Duke - North Carolina and Mississippi State vs. NE Louisiana at Florida High field.
