

Little Mike Augustine, an All-American in 1963, returned to form Saturday and delivered telling blows as Florida State squeezed out two victories at home over a scrappy Jacksonville University team.

The Seminoles won the first game 7-4, and the second 3-2, boosting their season record to 21-10.

Centerfielder Augustine was both goat and hero in the first game. His error on Ren Clark's single allowed three Jax runs to score in the eighth inning, tying the score at four-all. However, Augie evened things up with his first home run of the year, scoring two runs ahead of him in the home half of the eighth.

In the second game, Augustine reached first on a single, went all the way to third when second baseman Bill Knott threw wild on a double play grounder, then scored on a passed ball by Dolphin catcher Ben Weiland.

The run stood for six of the seven innings to be played in the second game, as Marty Howell bore down in quest of his fifth victory. However, Jax got to Howell in the seventh on Clark's single, Charles Matthews' sacrifice bunt, a double by Tom McMillian and a single by Knott.

Trailing 2-1 in the home half, Tom Thomas batted for Howell and reached second when left-fielder Joe Mosco dropped his Texas leaguer in short left. Speedster Monty McBryde came on to run for Thomas. Jim Reed laid a near perfect bunt down the third base line, and beat it out for a hit moving McBryde to third, and setting the stage for Augustine who responded with a sacrifice fly to deep right center to score the tying run.

Jax pitcher John Von Achen

got Gary Nichols on a fly to center, then Ken Suarez lined a single to center. Reed, in a beautiful display of baserunning got the jump going to second and moved all the way to third on the hit.

Bob Wilcox was intentionally walked, filling the bases, but Larry Johnson's bat wasn't needed as Reed scooted home with the winning run on Von Achen's second pitch — a wild one.

Cliff Ranew started the first game for the Seminoles but gave way to Ken Creely after the score was tied in the eighth. Creely let the water out of the Dolphin pool and won his third game in relief against no losses.

Reed walked to open the game, but was thrown out stealing second. Augustine—who has reached first and scored in the first inning of the last seven FSU games — also drew a walk, then came on to score on singles by Bob Wilcox and Suarez.

The Seminoles picked up another run in the second when speedster McBryde walked, then scored from first when pitcher Ed Petrosky threw wild on a pickoff attempt.

Bob Wilcox hit his fourth home run of the year—a towering blast just inside the left field foul line — in the third. The homer scored Augustine, who had singled and stolen second.

The losses gave Jacksonville a record of 5-20 for the season. Yesterday was the first time the two schools have met in baseball.

The Seminoles entertain Florida here this Friday and Saturday in the last home action of the year.
