DURHAM, N. C. — Florida
State's baseball team loosened
its hitting muscles after a week
layoff and clubbed Duke, 11-2,
here yesterday.

The Seinoles banged out 13 hits and Cliff Ranew gave up only four as he won his sixth game of the season against one loss.

Both Duke runs were unearned. The Tribe collected five unsarned runs on seven Duke errors.

Randy Brown's three - run triple in the second inning was the big hit. It came with two out after two runs had scored in the familiar Seminole hig inning.

Tom Thomas led off, and reached first on an error. Monty McBryde walked, and Wayne Giardino slapped a grounder to short, another error.

The second baseman's error on Ranew's grounder allowed Thomas to score, and Dick Fernandez hit a sacrifice fly scoring McBryde. Brown's triple then cleared the bases.

The Seminoles got two more in the third then two in each of the seventh and eighth innings.

Thomas again started the rally in the third this time with a single to right. McBryde walked, and Giardino was again safe

on an error. Ranew's fly scored Thomas, Fernandez walked,
and Maury Hopkins drove in
the other run with an infield hit.

In the seventh Fernandez
walked. Hopkins moved him to
third on the hit and run, and
he scored on a balk by the
Duke pitcher. Mike Martin's
single to right scored Hopkins.

McBryde led off the eighth
with a bunt single, then Giardino handcuffed the third baseman. Ranew hit into a double

play, but Fernandez tripled to bring in McBryde.

Hopkins got his third hit and second RBI on a single which scored Fernandez.

The game was the first in a six - game tour through the Carolinas. The Seminoles play N. C. State in Raleigh today at 3:00. Lefthander Marvin Stringfellow was scheduled to start against the Wolfpack.

The victory brought the FSU record to 15-3.
