

Wayne Vincent's 4-hit pitching and a strong ~~supporting performance afield~~ lifted Florida State to a 2-0 baseball victory over Georgia Southern here last night.

Now 24-9, following eight straight triumphs, the ~~Seminoles~~ face the Georgians again here today, at 2 p.m. Coach Fred Hatfield will send his unbeaten sophomore righthander, Ladon Boyd (7-0), against the Eagles' Jimmy Dobson (5-2).

For Southern, which has a ~~23-11~~ record, last night's loss was the 11th straight to the ~~Seminoles~~. It was also the first time the Statesboro team had been shut out in 34 games.

It didn't look much like a ~~Vincent~~ ~~shotout~~ at the start. First two Georgia Southern batters rapped out hits against Vincent, who had hurled a no-hitter against the Eagles at Statesboro a week ago.

Roddy Michele led off that first inning with a single — but Vincent picked him off first base. Then Rick Ward followed with a double. Vincent, however, retired the next two batters — and second base was as far as any Eagle got all evening.

As Vincent got stronger with each passing inning, he had the aid of some notable fielding plays — including two or three by third baseman Bob Canty, and single gems by second baseman Dick Gold, centerfielder Roy Mewborne and shortstop Jeff Hogan.

Mewborne went back near the 415-foot sign in center to grab a shot by Ken Szotkiewicz.

In boosting his record to 6-2, Vincent retired the last 17 Eagles in succession. He struck out six, including all three batters in the seventh, walked just one. The ~~Seminoles~~ played errorless ball behind him.

Meanwhile, FSU hitters were finding Jim Nevin tough, managing only six hits for the night. Nevin worked the first seven innings before leaving for a pinch-hitter.

Mewborne scored both of FSU's runs.

The first came in the fifth. After an out, Mewbourne walked after rightfielder Ward erred on his foul fly. Following the second out, John Bason drilled the ball between the third baseman and the bag, with the hit scoring Mewbourne.

In the seventh Mewbourne again walked, scored on Mike Eason's double to right center.
