Strong pitching continued to be the key as Florida State won its sixth game in seven starts Sunday with a 6-1 lacing of Georgia Southern.

Now 35-14 for the year, the Seminoles take a break from collegiate action as they tune up for a big three-game series against South Alabama this weekend in Mobile.

The Tribe will not be idle, however, as the Kansas City Royals Academy comes into Seminole Field for a pair of exhibition games tonight and Tuesday night.

The Tribe's young pitchers appear to be coming around as they limited Stetson and Georgia Southern to three runs in four games over the weekend.

Sunday Dave Price was the pitcher of record. The 6-2, 185, righthander turned in six strong innings, giving up just five hits. The Johnstown, Pa., sophomore was lifted for a pinch-hitter after taking a line shot back to the mound off his right thigh in the top of the inning. There was no apparent injury, except for a bruise and some soreness, but Coach Jack

Stallings wanted to take no chances.

John Keith and Mac Scarce worked the last three innings for the Tribe.

After spotting Southern its only run in the first, the Seminoles came right back with three in the bottom of the frame.

Dave Nichols and Dave Grimes walked, Ron Cash doubled sending one run home. Herb Sikes then singled sending in two more.

In the fifth, the Seminoles took advantage of a pair of errors by Eagle shortstop Steve Moening for three runs.
