QUOTES FROM FLORIDA STATE HEAD COACH WOODY WOODWARD

It was a fantastic season for us, but we certainly did not let the people of Omaha know the kind of team we have. We didn't even show them we knew how to play. We are not proud of the way we performed here, but I am proud of the way we played all season. We played some tough games to get here and it is really a shame for our seniors to have it end this way.

ON WAYNE MEARS' INJURY -- He was kicked in the leg above the shin guard on the play at the plate. It cramped up and was painful.

On LARRY JONES: "He just wasn't on. It was his poorest performance of the season. He was falling behind hitters and his fast ball wasn't moving like it usually does and the Seton Hall hitters were just laying back waiting for it.

"This is really a good ball club. I am just sorry we did not show it to the people here. Other than the play, everyone on our club really appreciated the treatment we received from the people at the Series."

SETON HALL QUINNERS:

FROM TODD HEIMER: My team just picked me up today. They played some real good defense and had plenty of offense. I threw about 40% knuckle balls. I don't think I threw one curve all day.

FROM RICK CERONE: I've been pressing a little bit though I've been making good contact. I just said to myself to relax. Then when I hit the homerun, everything changed. Now we have everything going for us going into tomorrow's game.

FROM MIKE SHEPPARD: I feel real good. The kids just came through. We waited for our good pitches and got them. Todd pitched really well. He just seems to get better and better as he goes along.
