

# Georgia homers top FSU

ATHENS, Ga. — John Basco belted a two-run homer in the seventh inning Thursday to boost Georgia to a 4-2 baseball victory over Florida State.

The loss snapped a four-game winning streak for the Seminoles. FSU, 23-10, plays Georgia State today at 2 p.m. in Atlanta.

FSU took a 1-0 lead in the second inning when Chris Cawthon led off with a triple and scored on a single by Joe Licata. Georgia, 7-8, tied the score in the third in Doug Schlechte's solo homer.

The Bulldogs went ahead in the fourth after Buck Belue, quarterback of Georgia's national championship football team, opened with a single. Belue was forced at second on Mike Wirth's grounder, but an error by second baseman Lionel Martinez and a single by Brad Weitzel loaded the bases. Basco's sacrifice fly scored Wirth.

Basco connected in the seventh off FSU starter Clem Freeman after Weitzel had singled with one out.

Mark Lacy's solo homer in the eighth, his third in three games and fourth of the season, pulled the Seminoles within two. They put the tying runs on base in the ninth when Martinez and Don DeLoach singled with one out, but Mike Fuentes struck out and Lacy flied out to right to end the game.

Fuentes again was frustrated in his bid for the NCAA career home run record. He was hitless in five at-bats, striking out twice, and remained two short of Bob Horner's mark of 56.

Right-hander Peyton Mosher, 3-2, went the distance for the Bulldogs, scattering 10 hits and striking out eight.

Freeman suffered his first loss after three victories.
