Florida State rallies, trips Gamecocks 7-5

COLUMBIA, S.C. — Florida State rallied for six runs in the seventh inning Friday night to post a come-from-behind 7-5 victory over South Carolina.

The victory, FSU's fifth in a row, moved the Seminoles to 35-16. South Carolina is 28-9.

The game began with a rhubarb in the first inning. With one out and Mike Fuentes on first, Jeff Ledbetter ground a ball to second base. The Gamecocks' second baseman elected to throw to first to catch Ledbetter, but overthrew and the ball rolled into the FSU dugout.

Fuentes, running with the hit, scored But South Carolina coach June Raines argued that Fuentes had not reached second when the overthrow occured. Fuentes was sent back to third, where he stayed as the next two outs were recorded, causing FSU coach Mike Martin to announce the

game was being played under protest.
Following the victory, Martin dropped his protest.
South Carolina struck for a run in

South Carolina struck for a run in its half of the inning, then chalked up three more runs in the third for a 4-0 lead. All four runs, produced with sev-

en hits, came off FSU starter Rick Hatcher who left the game in the fifth inning with a pulled muscle in his right (throwing) arm.
