First Inning

MIAMI -- Kutner walks. Parsons flies to center. Sorce flies to right. Kutner steals second as the ball gets into center field (E-2) and Kutner goes to third. DeJesus walks. Castro smashes a ~~XXXXXXXX~~ three run homer over the left field fence for his 15th of the year (ties a school record). Gil grounds to third. Three runs, one hit, one error and none left.

FLORIDA STATE -- Martinez grounds to short. DeLoach grounds to second. Fuentes grounds to second. No runs, no hits, no errors and none left.

Second Inning

MIAMI -- Seane grounds to second. Pagliarulo lines to first. Wrona grounds to short. No runs, no hits, no errors and none left.

FLORIDA STATE -- Lacy grounds to short. Ledbetter grounds to first who knocks it down then the pitcher picks up the loose ball and tags the bag. Licata singles to left. Mike Yastrzenski lines a two-run homer over the left field fence. Figueredo grounds to short. Two runs, two hits, no errors and none left.

Third Inning

MIAMI -- Kutner doubles to right. Parsons hits a slow roller down the first base line which the pitcher grabs and tags him; Kutner advances to third. Sorce singles to center to score Kutner. DeJesus grounds to the shortstop who allows the ball to roll through his legs (E-6); Sorce goes all the way to third. DeJesus steals second. Castro flies to center; Sorce tags and scores on the play. Gil hits a high bouncer to the third baseman which he has no play on; DeJesus goes to third. Seane grounds to second. Two runs, three hits, one error and two left.

FLORIDA STATE -- Ramsey flies to center. Martinez flies to center. DeLoach doubles down the left field line. Fuentes singles to left to score DeLoach. Lacy rips a two run homer over the 365 marker in left-center field. Ledbetter doubles to left. Licata grounds to short. Three runs, four hits, no errors and one left.

Fourth Inning

MIAMI -- David Smalley replaces Freeman on the mound. Pagliarulo doubles to left. Wrona hits a ground ball up the middle which the second baseman gets to but tries to make a desperate throw which gets past the first baseman (E-4); Wrona is credited with a single and Pagliarulo scores on the throw. Kutner lays down a sacrifice bunt that allows Wrona to advance to third. Parsons singles to center to score Wrona. Sorce singles to right. DeJesus lines to center. Castro flies to center. Two runs, four hits, one error and two left.

FLORIDA STATE -- Yastrzenski pops to third. Figueredo grounds to ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ the shortstop deep in the hole who tries to make a throw but it is high; he gets a single and goes to second on E-6. Ramsey singles to left to score Figueredo. Morrison picks Ramsey off first. Martinez singles to right. Brian Silva comes in to relieve Morrison. DeLoach strikes out swinging. One run, three hits, one error and ~~XXX~~ one left.

Fifth Inning

MIAMI -- Gil hits a high hopper to the shortstop who has no play. Seane walks. Pagliarulo attempts to bunt but pops it to the pitcher. Gil steals third and Seane steals second. Wrona singles to center to score Gil and Seane. Jaime Shouppe replaces Smalley on the mound. Kutner pops to third. Parsons grounds to third who flips to second to force Wrona. Two runs, two hits, no errors and none left.

FLORIDA STATE -- Fuentes walks. Lacy grounds to the shortstop who flips to second who relays to first for the 6-4-3 double play. Ledbetter grounds to third. No runs, no hits, no errors and none left.

Sixth Inning

MIAMI -- Sorce flies to deep left center as the center fielder catches against the wall. DeJesus smashes the next pitch way over the left field fence. Castro pops to the catcher. Gil walks. Gil gets picked off first.

One run, one hit, no errors and none left.

FLORIDA STATE -- Licata pops to the catcher. Yastrzemski lines to center. Figueroa strikes out swinging.

No runs, no hits, no errors and none left.

Seventh Inning

MIAMI -- Secane flies to center. Pagliarulo doubles to left. Wrona singles to right to score Pagliarulo. Kutner lays down a nifty sacrifice bunt that gets Wrona to second. Parsons grounds to short.

One run, two hits, no errors and one left.

FLORIDA STATE -- Ramsey grounds to short. Martinez is hit by a Silvas pitch. DeLoach strikes out swinging. Fuentes strikes out swinging.

No runs, no hits, no errors and one left.

Eighth Inning

MIAMI -- Ed Schneider replaces Shouppe. Sorce grounds to third. DeJesus grounds to short. Castro walks. Gil hits a high bouncer to the third baseman who tries to get Castro at second but the throw is late. Secane singles to center to score Castro. Gil goes to third and Secane to second on a wild pitch by Schneider. Pagliarulo strikes out.

One run, one hit, no errors and two left.

FLORIDA STATE -- Lacy pops to first. Ledbetter strikes out swinging. Licata flies to right.

No runs, no hits, no errors and none left.

Ninth Inning

MIAMI -- Wrona grounds to third. Kutner grounds to short. Parsons singles to center. Sorce grounds to third who throws the ball in the dirt allowing Parsons to go to third and Sorce to second (E-5); Calvin James comes in to run for Sorce. DeJesus doubles to score Parsons and James. ~~RM~~ Tony Barquin, pinch hitting for Frank Castro, strikes out looking.

Two runs, two hits, one error and one left.

FLORIDA STATE -- Browning replaces Silvas on the mound. Yastrzemski triples to right-center. Ken Huff, pinch hitting for Figueroa, strikes out swinging. Danny Dowell, who replaced Ramsey at catcher, strikes out swinging. Martinez grounds to short.

No runs, one hit, no errors and one left.

COACHES Q NOTES

MIAMI (COACH RON FRASER)

It wasn't the type of ballgame I expected, Jeff Morrison being our Number Two pitcher. In the early lead, we figured he could hold on. But he was missing and just didn't have good stuff today."

"Silvas came in like a tiger. His last four times in relief, he's looked good, but now he looks like a starter. The only way to relax a little bit during a game with a team that hits like Florida State is to get a great big lead and have someone throwing the way Silvas was."
