Play by Play

SOUTH ALABAMA FIRST: Blythe walks to open game. (Gailey visits mound as Little tosses fifth straight ball). Dennis Johnston grounds into a 3-6-3 double play. (Figueredo to Reed to Figueredo) Reed does a great job pulling down Figueredo's high throw. Proska walks on 3-2 pitch. Filotei strikes out on 1-2 pitch to end inning. No runs, no hits, no errors, one left. SA 0 ~~XXX~~ FSU 0

FLORIDA STATE FIRST: Barineau bounces out to second (Pierce to ~~HR~~ Filotei), one out; Reed lines out to left (Johnston), two outs; Figueredo flies out to right. No runs, no hits, no errors, none left. SA 0, FSU 0

SOUTH ALABAMA SECOND: Codinach bounces out to first (Figueredo unassisted), one out; Jim Loyd bounces single between Barineau and Reed. Pierce lines clean single to center. ~~So~~ Givens makes a great diving catch on Thames fly ball to shallow right, two out; Wilke flies out to Givens in right. No runs, two hits, no errors, two left. SA 0 FSU 0

FLORIDA STATE SECOND: Fazzini strikes out on high hard one, one out; ~~Yastrzemski~~ Yastrzemski singles to ~~left~~ right, Yastrzemski steals second cleanly. Givens lifts flyball to shallow center (Wilke), two out; Jones walks on ~~2x~~ 3-1 pitch to put runners on first and second. Dowell walks to load bases. Robinson lines out to deep right field, Lloyd makes catch against wall. No runs, one hit, no errors, three left. SA 0 FSU 0

SOUTH ALABAMA THIRD: Figueredo makes outstanding stop of Blythe's shot down first base line. Figueredo flips to Little covering, one out; Johnston flies out to ~~deep~~ deep left (Fazzini) ~~xx~~ two out; Proska grounds out to third (Barineau to Figueredo) No runs, no hits, no errors, none left. SA 0, FSU 0

FLORIDA STATE THIRD: BARINEAU draws walk to open inning. Reed hits a sharp single to left. Figueredo slows a home run deep over the right field wall—three run homer his 16th of the year. Fazzini hits short pop to center, second baseman makes play (Pierce), one out; ~~Yastrzemski~~ Yastrzemski singles to left. Givens bounces single between second and first. Runners on first and second, one out; Jones singles to left, Yastrzemski scores, Givens goes to third. Oliverio ~~xxx~~ leaves game in favor of John Clark. Dowell strikes out on 2-2 pitch, two out; Robinson flies out to deep centerfield. Four runs, ~~xxxxxx~~ five hits, no errors, two left. FSU 4, SA 0

SOUTH ALABAMA FOURTH: Jim Filotei strikes out on 1-2 pitch, one out; Codinach strikes out, two gone; Lloyd flies out to shallow left (fair ball territory) Reed drifts back to make catch. No runs, no hits, no errors, none left. FSU 4, SA 0

FLORIDA STATE FOURTH: Barineau walks after Clark goes 0-2. Reed skies high fly to left (Johnston) one out; Figueredo walks to put runners on first and second. Clark is out, Mark Estes replaces Clark as the South Alabama pitcher. Hit and run on, Fazzini singles in vacant hole at short, ~~xxxx~~ run scores. Yastrzemski hits sharp ball to third Codinach makes good play to ~~xx~~ Pierce for force out, first and third, two outs; Billy Ashford bats for Givens. Double steal on, Figueredo safe at home, Yas safe at second. Mild skirmish at home; Ashford flies out to ~~right~~ left (Johnston) ~~xx~~ Two runs on one hit, no errors, one left. FSU 6, SA 0

South Alabama Fifth: Pierce's fly ball to short right drops off Robinson's glove for a double. Thames grounds ball back to Little who ~~pass~~ proceeds to look runner back and pitch ball over Figuerado's head for a three base error, run scores. Wilke strikes out on three pitches. Barineau opts to go to first with Blythe's grounder, two out run scores. Figuerado makes second good stop of night on Johnston's sharply hit ball down first base line, flips to Little. Two runs, one hit, one error, none left, both runs unearned FSU 6 SA 2

Florida STATE FIFTH: Zoeller sends Wilke to deepest part of the park with flyball. Wilke makes catch crashing into the fence ~~for~~ one out; Dowell rips double to right center gap. Robinson walks. Barineau singles for RBI, left fielder throws ball away trying to get Dowell ~~fix~~ at plate, allows Robinson to score, Barineau ends up on third. Reed grounds to third, Barineau breaks for home is out on a rundown, two out, Reed at first. Reed steals second. Figuerado walks. Fazzini lines out sharply to center. Two runs, two hits, one error, one run earned. FSU #8, SA 2

SOUTH ALABAMA SIXTH: Nancy pinch hits on scoreboard. Prokask strikes out looking. Piloted grounds out to Little, two out. Codinach looks at a called str: three. No runs, no hits, no errors, none left. FSU8, SA 2

FLORIDA STATE SIXTH: Mike Yastrzemski strikes out on 2-2 pitch swinging, Mitchell bounces single to left. Joe Alter relieves Estes. Mitchell is caught stealing (Thames to Pierce), two outs, Zoeller walks. Dowell gets line drive sin: to left. First and second, two outs. Robinson bounces out to first (Piloted to Alter) No runs, two hits, no errors, two left. FSU 8, SA 2

SOUTH ALABAMA SEVENTH: Lloyd flies to left, one out, ~~x~~ Pierce goes ~~str~~ out Robinson to Figuerado, two out; Thames reaches on Barineau throwing error, Wilke reaches on another throwing error by Barineau. Little pulls string on Blythe for strikeout. No runs, no hits, two errors, two left. FSU 8 SA 2

FLORIDA STATE ~~EIGHTH~~ Seventh: Barineau strikes out, one gone; Reed strikes out on breaking pitch for two out on 3-2 count. Figuerado pops out harmlessly to catcher. No runs, no hits, no errors, none left. FSU 8, SA 2

SOUTH ALABAMA EIGHTH: Johnston bunts for single, pushes ball ~~lx~~ past Little. Prokask strikes out swinging, Johnston running on play steals second. Piloted flies out to deep right, Johnston tags on play makes it to third. (Mitchell), two outs; Codinach pops up to third (Barineau) No runs, ~~walks~~, one hit, no errors, one left. FLORIDA STATE 8, SOUTH ALABAMA 2

FLORIDA STATE EIGHTH: Fazzini strikes out on 1-2 pitch, one gone. Yastrzemski ~~pass~~ skies ball to deep right (~~John~~ Lloyd makes catch against wall), two out; Mitchell flies out to short ~~w~~ center. No runs, no hits, no errors, none left. FSU 8, SOUTH ALABAMA 2

SOUTH ALABAMA NINTH: Lloyd lines clean single up middle. Pierce hits bloop single to right. First and second no outs. -Doug Treadway is new Florida State pitcher. Thames strikes out swinging, one out; ~~Blythe~~ ~~Yastrzemski~~ ~~John~~ ~~Prokask~~ Wilkie walks to load bases. Blythe strikes out on 0-2 pitch, two gone; Johnston flies out to left (Fazzini). No runs, one hit, no errors, three left.

QUOTES FROM USA COACH EDDIE STANLEY:
