# CENTRAL MICHIGAN COACH DEAN KREINER:

"It was similar to what I thought yesterday, I thought they were a beatable club and that we had a shot at them. Statistically everything on the board indicated that, except we didn't score the runs. They had seven hifs and we had II, they had three errors. So the opportunities for us to score runs were there. With II hits you have to score more than two runs, so we needed a few clutch hits and were unable to get those.

"I thought Tom did an excellent job pitching. He has not pitched for four years, he had arm trouble in his senior year in high school and had some surgery and has not been back. So I think he did an excellent job. I'm real proud of the job he did.

"I was pleased with the way we played, but we just needed a key hif."

"When I looked at their team they looked not as strong in the infield as they have in the past, they've had some fantastic infielders and I'm sure they have exdellent infielders this year. But when you look at their stats they have quite a few errors in the infield.

"Theoothertthing is yesterday the catcher did not throw well, and he had an excellent game today. It was not his fault that we stole third. It was a critical time their in the eighth inning when we stole third and second on him, which set us up for a base hif to win the ball game. But if was because the shortstop and second baseman just gave it away, they did hot hold us. At that point it was a 3-2 game and by moving men that was the winning run. We showed courage enough: to come and take it.

"When he struck out Matt Bauer in the ninth imning, jammed him with a fastball, I think that took courage to get the ball in. And he did hif the spot."

"Now it's time for me to speak up for baseball in the North. The competifion down here was good but I also think we can play with the better teams in the country. We've been in the NCAA Tournament now ten years and haven't gotten through to the Regional, but we are so close."

# FLORIDA STATE COACH MIKE MARTIN:

"For a 27-out ball game, and they're first and they in nobody out; and Pedro threw the guy out stealing and we walked the next hifter and got the double-play ball, that was a big lift. I don't know whether it was the next inning or the next inning that we scored, but that first inning was a mighty big lift to the 'Noles.

"Very pleased obviously with Gregory and Kimball, and certainly we have a tendency to forget one of the best catchers in the game and that's Pete Grifol.

"I was thinking the zero (errors) was ours. The only one I was thinking about was there at the end. They're a part of the game; we obviously don't like 'em.

"It makes the pitcher bear down a little more. We know that we're not going to be able to make errors against the three ofher teams that are in this thing;

"I was very impressed with Central Michigan. We played well and had to to beat a good offensive club. We did a great job of pitching to the MAC player of the year, McNamara. Wenheld him down real well, he reminds me of Kelly at Arizona State, we held him to four hits.

on Kimball—"Ricky has been in that situation a lot of times, he has failed and he has succeeded. That is the mark of a good reliever. Rickey, the makeup that he has, he enjoys that. And let is face it, Central Mixhigan was playing in a loser's round game for them, they had a little b f more of a pressure situation for them. We had a little bit of an advantage there.

8th Inning decision—"He was gone, Plain and simple. He had thrown a good game. Guysh it's tough when you've got a reliever like Kimball and you've got a guy up there that's thrown 110 pitches. It's a pretty easy decision to go get Ricky."
