TOP OF THE FIRST (FSU): Bevis walks. Ronan flies out to center (1 out). Bargas singles to right; Bevis to third. Roberts pops out to second (2 out). Parker strikes out swinging (3 out).
0 runs, 1 hit, 0 errors, 2 left

BOTTOM OF THE FIRST (CMU): McNamara doubles to left-center. Dreasky reaches on infield single; McNamara to third. Dreasky caught stealing second (2-4 putout) (1 out). Bauer walks. Green grounds into double play (4-6-3) (3 out).
0 runs, 2 hits, 0 errors, 1 left

TOP OF THE SECOND (FSU): Tamayo grounds out to second (1 out). Grifol lines out to center (2 out). Perez walks. Perez steals second. Rau hit by pitch. Bevis doubles into right field corner scoring Perez; Rau to third. Ronan walks to load the bases. Rau scores and runners advance one base on wild pitch. Bargas lines out to short (3 out).
2 runs, 1 hit, 0 errors, 2 left

BOTTOM OF THE SECOND (CMU): Dowd strikes out looking (1 out). Ritter walks. Epple walks. MacGregor grounds into double play (6-4-3) (3 out).
0 runs, 0 hits, 0 errors, 1 left

TOP OF THE THIRD (FSU): Roberts flies out to right (1 out). Parker strikes out looking (2 out). Tamayo doubles down left field line. Grifol lines out to center (3 out).
0 runs, 1 hit, 0 errors, 1 left

BOTTOM OF THE THIRD (CMU): Dahley strikes out looking (1 out). McNamara walks. Dreasky reaches on fielder's choice; McNamara out at second (3-6 putout) (2 out). Dreasky to second on wild pitch. Bauer grounds out to first (3 out).

TOP OF THE FOURTH (FSU): Perez grounds out to first (1 out). Rau pops out to catcher (2 out). Bevis walks. Ronan grounds into fielder's choice; Bevis out at second (6-4 putout) (3 out).

BOTTOM OF THE FOURTH (CMU): Green flies out to center (1 out). Dowd singles to right. Ritter strikes out looking (2 out). Dowd caught stealing second (2-4 putout) (3 out).

GAME FIVE: FLORIDA STATE 4, CENTRAL MICHIGAN 2

CENTRAL MICHIGAN COACH DEAN KREINER:

"It was similar to what I thought yesterday, I thought they were a beatable club and that we had a shot at them. Statistically everything on the board indicated that, except we didn't score the runs. They had seven hits and we had 11, they had three errors. So the opportunities for us to score runs were there. With 11 hits you have to score more than two runs, so we needed a few clutch hits and were unable to get those.

"I thought Tom did an excellent job pitching. He has not pitched for four years, he had arm trouble in his senior year in high school and had some surgery and has not been back. So I think he did an excellent job. I'm real proud of the job he did.

"I was pleased with the way we played, but we just needed a key hit."

"When I looked at their team they looked not as strong in the infield as they have in the past, they've had some fantastic infielders and I'm sure they have excellent infielders this year. But when you look at their stats they have quite a few errors in the infield.

"The other thing is yesterday the catcher did not throw well, and he had an excellent game today. It was not his fault that we stole third. It was a critical time their in the eighth inning when we stole third and second on him, which set us up for a base hit to win the ball game. But it was because the shortstop and second baseman just gave it away, they did not hold us. At that point it was a 3-2 game and by moving men that was the winning run. We showed courage enough to come and take it.

"When he struck out Matt Bauer in the ninth inning, jammed him with a fastball, I think that took courage to get the ball in. And he did hit the spot."

"Now it's time for me to speak up for baseball in the North. The competition down here was good but I also think we can play with the better teams in the country. We've been in the NCAA Tournament now ten years and haven't gotten through to the Regional, but we are so close."

FLORIDA STATE COACH MIKE MARTIN:

"For a 27-out ball game, and they're first and third with nobody out; and Pedro threw the guy out stealing and we walked the next hitter and got the double-play ball, that was a big lift. I don't know whether it was the next inning or the next inning that we scored, but that first inning was a mighty big lift to the 'Noles.

"Very pleased obviously with Gregory and Kimball, and certainly we have a tendency to forget one of the best catchers in the game and that's Pete Grifol.

"I was thinking the zero (errors) was ours. The only one I was thinking about was there at the end. They're a part of the game; we obviously don't like 'em.

"It makes the pitcher bear down a little more. We know that we're not going to be able to make errors against the three other teams that are in this thing."

"I was very impressed with Central Michigan. We played well and had to beat a good offensive club. We did a great job of pitching to the MAC player of the year, McNamara. We held him down real well, he reminds me of Kelly at Arizona State, we held him to four hits.

On Kimball--"Ricky has been in that situation a lot of times, he has failed and he has succeeded. That's the mark of a good reliever. Rickey, the makeup that he has, he enjoys that. And let's face it, Central Michigan was playing in a loser's round game for them, they had a little bit more of a pressure situation for them. We had a little bit of an advantage there.

8th Inning decision--"He was gone. Plain and simple. He had thrown a good game. Guys, it's tough when you've got a reliever like Kimball and you've got a guy up there that's thrown 110 pitches. It's a pretty easy decision to go get Ricky."
