Florida State 4, Arizona State 3 (10 innings)

TALLAHASSEE --Link Jarrett's sacrifice fly in the bottom of the 10th scored Eduardo Perez to lift Florida State to a 4-3 win over Arizona State Sunday in college baseball action at Dick Howser Stadium.

A crowd of 4,108 saw FSU defeat the top-ranked Sun Devils to sweep the three-game series. Sunday's game marked the second time in the three games that FSU scored two runs in the bottom of the 10th to win. The sweep improved Florida State's record to 6-0 on the season while Arizona State dropped to 8-4.

Jarrett's sac fly ended a wild 10th for Florida State that began when Nandy Serrano was hit by a pitch from ASU reliever Tony Pena, 0-2, the third Sun Devil pitcher of the game. Eduardo Perez then laid a perfect bunt for a single. Pena was unable to pick up a sacrifice bunt by pinch-hitter Allen Bevis and the bases were loaded for Pedro Grifol. Grifol hit a sharp come-backer to the mound which Pena fielded, but catcher Clarke Rea couldn't handle Pena's throw and Serrano scored the tying run.

FSU's comeback made a winner of Seminole reliever Ricky Kimball. Kimball, who broke the FSU records for career appearances and relief appearances Sunday, is 1-0.

Arizona State had gone ahead in the top of the 10th on Rea's RBI single, which scored Dave Robson, who had reached on a walk.

The Tribe sent the game into extra innings with a run in the ninth. Grifol singled, advanced to second on a wild pitch by Scott Dodd and took third on Jarrett's bunt single. Chris Roberts then hit into a double play, allowing Grifol to score.

Late-inning action obscured a pair of tremendous pitching performances by starting pitchers Roberts of Florida State and Gary Tatterson of ASU. Roberts struck out 10 and did not walk a batter in nine innings. He allowed four hits, including two solo home runs, by Robson in the second and Todd Steverson in the seventh. At one point, he retired 16 straight ASU hitters.

Tatterson allowed one earned run in eight plus innings of work. He struck out four, walked two and gave up eight hits.

Tony Liebsack led Florida State with three hits while Eduardo Perez added a pair for the Seminoles. No ASU player had more than one hit and the Sun Devils were limited to five hits and only eight baserunners in the game.

Florida State travels to Tucson, Ariz. for a three-game series with the Arizona Wildcats beginning Thursday. ASU plays host to Texas next weekend in Tempe.
