FLORIDA STATE BASEBALL
February 24, 1991

TALLAHASSEE -- Eduardo Perez' seventh-inning double scored Tony Liebsack to break a 4-4 tie and Florida State went on to an 8-5 victory over Minnesota for a sweep of the three-game series. Fourth-ranked Florida State improved to 10-2 with the victory while Minnesota dropped to 0-3.

FSU overcame a 4-1 deficit by scoring three runs in the sixth inning. Pedro Grifol's two-out double off the right field wall scored Nandy Serrano, who had reached on an error, and Perez, who had walked. After starter Jeff Schmidt, who surrendered only two hits in 5.1 innings of work, was lifted in favor of Chris Lawler, Chris Roberts doubled to send Grifol home and tie the game.

The Seminoles broke the tie in the seventh off Lawler, 0-1. With one out, Liebsack walked and went to second on Link Jarrett's single. After Serrano lined out, Perez' double broke the tie. Kenny Felder followed with a two-run single to put the Seminoles up 7-4. Grifol finished the rally with an RBI single that scored Felder.

Felder and Grifol led the Seminoles offensively with two hits apiece and five RBI between them.

Kenny Robinson, who entered the game in the fourth inning in relief of Roberts, picked up his second victory of the year. He was relieved in the eighth after giving up an RBI single to Brian Hartmann. Ricky Kimball finished up for FSU to record his second save.

The Golden Gophers took a 4-0 lead after three innings. In the top of the first, singles by Greg Johnson and Jeff Monson and a walk to Brian Hartmann loaded the bases with one out. When Joe Wallraf's double play ball was mishandled, then thrown away, by FSU shortstop Link Jarrett, a pair of runs scored.

UM added another unearned run in the second, Keith Krenke scoring on Bill Mobilia's single. Minnesota's fourth run came on Brent Gates' second home run of the year, a solo shot to left in the third.

The Golden Gophers brought the tying run to the plate with two outs in the ninth after a single and an error. But Gates was called out on strikes and the Seminoles recorded their 13th straight victory in Dick Howser Stadium.

For the second day in a row, UM outhit the Seminoles (10-8). John Kopfer led the Golden Gophers with two hits.
