TALLAHASSEE -- Chris Roberts and Nandy Serrano collected three hits apiece and Roberts scattered seven hits and struck out seven in over seven innings on the mound to lead Florida State to a 5-3 victory over Florida Sunday before a crowd of 4,480 in Dick Howser Stadium.

The victory, FSU's seventh straight this year and 18th straight in Dick Howser Stadium over the past two years, lifted the second-ranked Seminoles record to 17-3 on the year. Florida, ranked 20th in the country, fell to 11-9 with the loss.

Florida State took advantage of six Gator errors, including three by reserve shortstop Jason Beaird, as four of the Seminoles' five runs were unearned. Marc Valdes was tagged with the loss to fall to 3-1 after allowing 10 hits and striking out two over five and two-thirds innings.

FSU went ahead 1-0 in the first when Roberts' reached on a bunt single, went to second when Kenny Felder was hit by a pitch, and scored when Beaird threw a double-play relay away.

The Seminoles added a pair of runs in the third, again with the help of an error by Beaird. Allen Bevis reached on a Beaird error, stole second and advanced to third on Serrano's bunt single. He scored when Eduardo Perez hit into a double play. After Pedro Grifol singled, Roberts drove him in with a double.

Florida State added single runs in the fifth and sixth to build a 5-0 lead on UF while Roberts held the Gators scoreless through the first six innings. Florida scored its first run in the seventh when Brent Killen's fly ball was misplayed for an error by Garrett Blanton and pinch hitter Jimmy Bell's single plated Killen.

UF chased Roberts, 3-1, in the eighth when Herbert Perry blasted a one out solo home run and Mario Linares doubled. John Nedeau came on to finish up to earn his first save of the year. The Gators added another run in the ninth on a pair of singles and an error, but Brian Purvis' grounder to first ended the threat and the game.

Roberts and Serrano were the only Seminoles with more than one hit while Brian Duva and Linares led UF with two hits apiece.

The Seminoles play host to Richmond in a three-game set beginning Tuesday while the Gators are at South Florida Wednesday.
