TALLAHASSEE -- Three Florida State pitchers combined to strike out 14 and FSU made the most of its seven hits to take a 6-2 victory over Richmond Wednesday evening at Dick Howser Stadium.

Florida State, ranked first by both Collegiate Baseball and Baseball America, extended its winning streak to nine games and improved its record to 19-3 on the year. Richmond fell to 4-5 on the season.

Freshman Bryan Harris struck out eight while allowing only four hits to pick up his first collegiate victory in his first career start. Tim Davis relieved in the sixth with the Seminoles leading 3-2 and held the Spiders off.

FSU scored a run in the first with two outs when Eduardo Perez singled, stole second and scored on Pedro Grifol's single. Grifol picked up his ~~second~~ second RBI in the third on a bases-loaded sacrifice fly. Chris Roberts added an RBI single in the inning to extend his hitting streak to 11 games.

Clinging to a 3-2 lead, FSU came through with a pair of runs in the sixth to move the margin to 5-2. After back-to-back doubles by Kenny Felder and Ty Mueller put runners on second and third, Garrett Blanton's safety squeeze bunt scored Felder. Then Mueller walked home when UR pitcher Rick Jarvis balked.

Jarvis gave up all six FSU runs over eight innings to fall to 0-2.

Mueller led FSU with two hits while Kevin McNamara had a pair of single for Richmond.
