TALLAHASSEE -- FSU's Chris Roberts retired the first 18 Michigan batters he faced and went on to pitch a complete game one-hitter as Florida State defeated the Wolverines 3-0 in collegiate baseball action Saturday.

Roberts, who improved to 4-1 with the victory, was masterful as he faced only 28 batters in the contest. The sophomore from Middleburg, Fla., allowed only a seventh-inning single by UM's Scott Timmerman. FSU shortstop Link Jarrett got a glove on the ball hit up the middle, but could not make the play. Timmerman was erased by a double play and UM got only one other runner on base, also in the seventh, when leftfielder Eduardo Perez misplayed Tim Flannelly's liner for a two-base error. Roberts struck out 13 and did not walk a batter in the game.

Roberts collected twice as many hits as he allowed the Wolverines as he led the Seminoles offensively with a double and a single. FSU had only four hits on the day, but one was a two-run homer by Nandy Serrano in the sixth to give Roberts the three-run cushion. Florida State scored its first run in the fourth when Eduardo Perez reached on an infield single and went to second on an overthrow, advanced to third on a wild pitch and scored on Pedro Grifol's grounder to third.


Michigan's Russell Brock struck out nine and allowed only four hits over seven innings, but his record dropped to 2-2 on the year.

The victory extended FSU's winning streak to 12 games as the top-ranked Seminoles improved to 22-3 on the season. Michigan, ranked 13th, fell to 8-5 with the loss.

The two teams conclude the three-game series Sunday at 2 p.m.
