Florida State 3, Northern Iowa 0

TALLAHASSEE -- For the second day in a row three Florida State pitchers combined to shut out Northern Iowa, giving FSU a 3-0 victory, a sweep of the three-game series with UNI and its 15th straight win.

Top-ranked Florida State's record improved to 25-3 with the three-hit victory engineered by Seminole hurlers John Wasdin, LaWhit Lizzmore and John Nedeau.

Wasdin, 3-0, got the win as he faced only 15 batters in his five innings of action. UNI's leadoff batter in the fourth, P. J. Conlon, looped a single over first base, but was erased on a pickoff. Lizzmore struck out four and allowed only hit in his two innings while Nedeau struck out three over the final two frames to pick up his third save of the season. FSU notched its fifth shutout of the year and second in as many days.

Florida State collected only six hits off UNI starter and loser Brandon Murray, 0-2, but it was enough. Murray walked three and struck out four over seven innings.

He gave up a leadoff triple to catcher Marc Dunbar in the third and Dunbar scored one batter later on Nandy Serrano's groundout to third base. The Seminoles added a pair of runs in the fourth. Pedro Grifol and Chris Roberts each singled and Ty Mueller plated Grifol with a sacrifice fly to centerfield. Tony Liebsack followed with a single to score Roberts.

Florida State's 15-game winning streak is its longest since 1982. The Seminoles have also posted 26 straight victories in Dick Howser Stadium, dating back to 1990.

Northern Iowa is winless in 11 games this year.

FSU opens Metro Conference play Saturday night at 7 p.m. with the first game in a three-game set against Southern Miss, 13-9.
