Florida State 5, Southern Mississippi 0

TALLAHASSEE -- Florida State's Chris Roberts threw his second consecutive complete game shutout and drove in a pair of runs with a double to lead FSU to a 5-0 victory over Metro Conference foe Southern Miss Saturday night before 2,540 at Dick Howser Stadium.

Roberts' four-hitter lifted FSU's 1991 record to 27-3, 2-0 in the Metro, and extended the Seminoles' winning streak to 17 games. Florida State has won 28 straight games at home dating back to the 1990 season.

Roberts, who had a one-hit shutout last Saturday against Michigan, worked out of jams in the second, third and fourth innings before setting down 18 of the last 19 Golden Eagles he faced. USM's best scoring opportunity came in the fourth when Andy Woodard led off with a walk and went to third on Larry Wesson's double. But Roberts retired the next three batters on an infield pop up, a grounder back to the pitcher and a bouncer to second, and allowed only one hit the rest of the way. His record improved to 5-1 on the season.

Florida State got all the runs it would need in the fourth off USM starter and loser Mark Carson, 2-2. Nandy Serrano led off with an infield single and went to second on Eduardo Perez' hit. Serrano scored when second baseman Scotty Jurich's double play relay throw on Pedro Grifol's grounder was wild. One out later, Ty Mueller's single scored Grifol.

The Seminoles added three insurance runs in the seventh inning. Allen Bevis, who had a pair of doubles on the night, reached on an error and was sacrificed to second. Perez then greeted USM reliever Tony Phillips with a single to right to score Bevis. After Grifol singled, Roberts doubled to the gap in right center to drive in Perez and Grifol.

Southern Miss' record fell to 13-11, 2-3, with the loss. The two teams complete the three-game series Sunday at 2 p.m. at Dick Howser Stadium.
