Florida State 14, Mercer 5

TALLAHASSEE -- Top-ranked Florida State exploded for eight runs in the bottom of the seventh inning to take a come-from-behind 14-5 victory over Mercer Wednesday evening in college baseball action at Dick Howser Stadium.

The Seminoles eight-run uprising was capped by Kenny Felder's grand slam home run off the third Mercer pitcher of the inning, Jim Cole. Felder had arrived at the stadium in the second inning after taking part in spring football practice during the afternoon.

In the FSU seventh, Ty Mueller led off with a walk and Link Jarrett tripled to tie the score at five. After a strikeout, Jarrett scored on the first of four consecutive singles by FSU batters which knocked out both Adams Ropp, who took the loss for the Bears to fall to 0-4, and reliever Darius Solomon. Cole came in and walked Chris Roberts to reload the bases, then surrendered Felder's slam, his fourth home run of the year. Howard Davidson followed and got the next two outs, but gave up two more runs on a walk and three singles in the FSU eighth.

Six Seminoles collected at least two hits apiece to pace FSU's 16-hit attack. Eduardo Perez led the way with a 3-for-4 outing and Pedro Grifol drove in three runs, two on a first-inning home run, his ninth of the year.


The Bears, 9-16, took a 3-0 lead off FSU starter John Wasdin on John Callihan's three-run homer in the first. Callihan also doubled and singled on the day to lead Mercer with three hits.

Mercer touched Wasdin for single runs in the third and fourth as well to go ahead 5-4. Callihan picked up his fourth RBI in the third with a double to score Kyle Rose while Todd McCain blasted his first home run of the year, a solo shot, in the fourth. Wasdin was relieved in the sixth by LaWhit Lizzmore, who was the beneficiary of FSU's comeback. Lizzmore, 1-0, allowed only one hit and struck out three in three innings.

The victory extended Florida State's winning streak to 20 games and improved its record to 30-3 on the year. FSU will attempt to tie the school record for victories Friday night at Memphis State.
