TALLAHASSEE -- Florida State's Roger Bailey hurled a complete-game seven hitter and struck out 10 to pitch second-ranked Florida State to a 5-2 victory over third-rated Miami Friday night before a crowd of 6,032, second largest in school history.

In pitching his second consecutive complete game, Bailey scattered seven hits and walked only one to improve his record to 7-1 on the year. Only one of the two Miami runs was earned.

Florida State's victory tied the school record of 32 for consecutive home wins, held by the 1978 FSU team. The record includes all 28 of the Seminoles' home contests in 1991. Overall, Florida State improved to 35-6 while Miami dropped to 34-8 as they had a 10-game winning streak snapped.

The Seminoles collected 12 hits off UM starter and loser Shawn Purdy, 5-2. FSU scored twice each in the first and second to take a 4-0 lead before Purdy settled down and allowed only one run the rest of the way. He went the distance, but was charged with all five earned runs.

FSU's Allen Bevis, who went 3-for-4 on the night, led off the Seminole first with an infield single and stole second. He scored on Eduardo Perez' single two batters later. After Pedro Grifol singled for the first of his two hits on the night, Chris Roberts' sacrifice fly scored Perez as the Seminoles jumped out to a 2-0 lead.

In the second, Link Jarrett reached on an infield single and went to third on Marc Dunbar's double, the only extra base hit of the game for either team. Bevis singled, scoring Jarrett. After a pop out, with runners on first and third, Perez struck out. But Bevis, who was stealing, got caught in a rundown long enough for Dunbar to score from third with FSU's fourth run.

Bailey worked out of his most serious jam in the fifth. With the bases loaded and no out after a single and a pair of errors, he got UM's Gino DiMare to hit into a double play, scoring Alex Miranda with an unearned run. With Chris Anderson on third, Seminoles Nandy Serrano and Eduardo Perez combined to make a fantastic play for the third out to save a run. Serrano dove to stop Mike Tosar's drive and Perez stretched a full body length while keeping his foot on the bag when Serrano's throw was in the dirt and to the far right of the base.

Bailey gave up his only earned run of the game in the ninth despite striking out the side. Pinch-hitter Johnathan Smith singled and stole second. After two outs, Frank Mora singled down the right field line. But Bailey struck out Luis Hernandez to give FSU game one of this three-game series.

The two teams continue the intra-state battle Saturday night at 7 p.m. at Dick Howser Stadium.
