Florida State 6, Louisville 3

TALLAHASSEE -- Kenny Felder hit a two-out grand slam homer in the bottom of the seventh inning to lift Florida State to a 6-3 victory over Louisville Friday night in Metro Conference collegiate baseball action before a crowd of 1,591 at Dick Howser Stadium.

Florida State trailed Louisville 3-1 entering the seventh as UL ace Rod Biehl, 5-5, limited FSU to only one hit through the first six innings. Felder's homer, his sixth of the season, came after Tony Liebsack walked to lead off the inning. After two strikeouts, Eduardo Perez doubled down the left field line. After Pedro Grifol walked to load the bases, Felder blasted a 2-2 pitch from Biehl over the wall in right centerfield to give the top-ranked Seminoles a 5-3 lead.

Florida State added another run in the inning off UL reliever Glenn Meyers.

FSU fell behind 2-0 in the fourth on a walk to Dan Kopriva, an infield single by Darren Oppel, a wild pitch and Rob Newman's RBI single off FSU starter Jimmy Lewis. Lewis was lifted in the fifth after UL loaded the bases on two walks and a single. Bryan Harris came on in relief and pitched the final four-and-a-third innings, giving up only one hit the rest of the way to improve his record to 4-0.

Florida State improved to 39-7 with the win, 8-2 in the Metro Conference while Louisville fell to 19-25, 3-10.

In addition to Felder's heroics, Ty Mueller had a pair of hits for Florida State. Six Louisville players picked up one hit apiece.

The two teams continue the series Saturday at 7 p.m.
