TALLAHASSEE -- Jacksonville's Ty Boykin blasted a three-run homer and drove in four runs to lead the Dolphins to a 7-4 victory over Florida State Monday night, breaking FSU's 37-game home winning streak.

The Seminoles, ranked second by Baseball America and third by Collegiate Baseball in polls released earlier today, lost at home for the first time in over a year and dropped to 41-10 on the season. Florida State was pinned with its third straight loss, the first time since 1989 the Seminoles have lost three straight.

Boykin began the scoring with a three-run home run, his 11th of the year, in the second off FSU starter and loser Bryan Harris, 4-1. Harris departed in the third after giving up four earned runs on six hits.

The Dolphins took a 4-0 lead before FSU's Ty Mueller made it 4-1 with a solo home run in the fourth, his fourth homer of the year.

Jacksonville ace John Wylie, 9-3, picked up the win despite allowing 10 hits over five innings. Reliever Rod Van Dyke allowed only three hits and one FSU run the rest of the way to pick up his second save. The Seminoles stranded 11 runners in the game.

JU improved to 33-15-1 with the victory while Florida State fell to 41-10.

Boykin went 2-for-5 with four RBI to lead Jacksonville while Dan Halpern added three hits and scored twice. Eduardo Perez led the Seminole offense with four hits in five at bats and Nandy Serrano picked up three hits in a losing effort.

The Seminoles take on Miami in a three-game series in Miami beginning Friday while Jacksonville travels to Stetson for a Tuesday night game with the Hatters.
