FLORIDA STATE BASEBALL

Florida State 4, College of Charleston 1

TALLAHASSEE -- Four Florida State pitchers combined on a four-hitter and Chris Roberts drove in three runs with a pair of hits to lead FSU to a 4-1 victory over Charleston Sunday afternoon before a crowd of 2,099 at Dick Howser Stadium.

The seventh-ranked Seminoles scored three runs in the first inning, the first two on Roberts' home run off the top of the scoreboard in leftfield. Roberts' single in the second drove in FSU's final run of the game as Cougar righthander Ned Timmerman shut down the Seminoles over the final six innings.

Florida State hurlers combined for 16 strikeouts on the afternoon, led by starter and winner Jim Rushworth (1-0), who struck out six over his four-inning stint, and closer Tim Davis, who fanned six in the final three frames to pick up his first save of the season. FSU pitchers struck out at least two Cougar batters in four of the last five innings.

Charleston scored its lone run in the fourth after Eddie Wagner, who had two of the Cougars' four hits, doubled. Wagner scored on Adam Brown's single.

Third baseman Nandy Serrano went three-for-four to lead Florida State's seven-hit attack.

The Seminoles travel to Tempe, Ariz. next weekend for a three-game series against 19th-ranked Arizona State.
