TALLAHASSEE -- Sixth-ranked Florida State used a seven-run first inning and the relief pitching of John Wasdin and John Nedeau to beat Virginia Military Institute 10-4 Friday afternoon in college baseball action in Tallahassee.

The Seminoles, 4-1, scored seven times on six hits in the first off VMI starter and loser Billy Goodrich, 0-1. Ty Mueller's double scored a pair of runs, but the big blast in the inning came off the bat of senior Chris Brock, who blasted his first career home run, a three-run shot, to give FSU a 6-0 lead. Allen Bevis doubled in Marc Dunbar with the final run of the frame as FSU sent 11 men to the plate in the first.

VMI, 0-1, closed to within three runs by scoring a pair of runs in both the second and the fifth innings off FSU starter and winner Roger Bailey, 2-0. David Procise singled to drive in two runs in the second.

In the fifth, the Keydets scored twice more on four singles.

Bob Armstrong closed the Seminole scoring in the fifth with a three-run homer off VMI reliever Chris Tujo. Wasdin entered the game in the sixth and allowed only one base runner, on an error, in three innings of work. He struck out eight of the 10 batters he faced while Nedeau set VMI down in order in the ninth.

Mueller and Dunbar led FSU with two hits apiece as eight of FSU's nine starters collected at least one hit. Raymond Flowers and John Payne had two hits each to pace VMI's offense.

Florida State and VMI continue the three-game series Saturday at noon.
