Florida State 20, VMI 0

TALLAHASSEE -- Florida State's Chris Roberts blasted a pair of home runs and drove in five to lead an 18-hit Seminole attack as FSU defeated Virginia Military Institute 20-0 in college baseball action Saturday afternoon.

Seminole hitters cracked five home runs and stole six bases while a pair of FSU pitchers limited VMI to only three hits and no runs in the rain-shortened game. The contest was called in the bottom of the seventh due to rain and lightening.

Florida State scored 11 runs in the first two frames to build an early lead. In the first, FSU scored six runs on six hits with Link Jarrett's single driving in a pair. Roberts' first home run, a two-run shot, came in the second off VMI starter and loser Marc Phillips, 0-1. His second drive came in the sixth off VMI's third pitcher, Donny Holloway, and gave FSU a 16-0 lead.

Meanwhile, FSU pitchers Jim Rushworth and Paul Wilson quieted the Keydet bats. Starter Rushworth, 2-1, picked up the win with four innings of work. He struck out three and allowed all three VMI hits. Wilson pitched the final three frames and faced only 10 batters without giving up a hit. No VMI batter had more than one hit.

Jarrett, Chris Brock and Grady Jordan joined Roberts to power FSU's offense. Jarrett's day included three hits, a pair of doubles, and three RBI. Jordan scored four and drove in four. His two hits included a two-run home run which closed the scoring.

Sixth-ranked Florida State improved to 5-1 on the year while VMI's record fell to 0-2. The two teams conclude the three-game set Sunday at 2 p.m. at Dick Howser Stadium.
