Florida State 14, Charleston Southern 2

TALLAHASSEE -- Third-ranked Florida State scored in each of the last five innings in a 14-2 rout over Charleston Southern Tuesday in college baseball action in Tallahassee.

The Seminoles, 12-3, scored four runs on four hits in the fourth off Charleston starter and loser Jim Maas, 1-2. Grady Jordan led off the inning with a walk. Back-to-back doubles by Chris Roberts and Nandy Serrano pushed Jordan and Roberts home. Ty Mueller had an RBI single and scored later on Tony Liebsack's sacrifice fly.

In the next inning, FSU exploded for six runs, three on Allen Bevis' round-tripper. The Seminole bats combined for nine extra-base hits on the day, including seven doubles.

Meanwhile, sophomore Bryan Harris picked up his first win of the season with six innings of one-hit ball. Harris struck out three and walked none before giving way to John Wasdin in the seventh. Wasdin picked up his first save while closing for the Seminoles.

First baseman Doug Hutto led the way for the Buccaneers, now 4-5. Hutto was two-for-four at the plate with an RBI single in the seventh.

The two-game series concludes Wednesday at 3:30 p.m. at Howser Stadium.
