Florida State 13, Charleston Southern 8

TALLAHASSEE -- Florida State used a 14-hit attack and the relief pitching of senior Tim Davis to take a 13-8 victory over Charleston Southern in college baseball action in Tallahassee Wednesday.

The third-ranked Seminoles, 13-3, got a scare from the Buccaneers, 4-6, in the fourth when CSU scored seven runs to take a 7-5 lead. FSU starter Paul Wilson gave up all seven runs as Charleston Southern sent 13 men to the plate in the frame and used seven hits and a pair of Florida State errors to forge ahead.

FSU third baseman Nandy Serrano tied the game in the bottom of the fourth with a two-run homerun off Buccaneer starter and loser Lee Miller, 2-1. Serrano had a pair of hits, a pair of RBI and scored two runs on the day.

The Seminoles went ahead to stay in the fifth on back-to-back doubles by Link Jarrett and Tony Liebsack and added two runs in the sixth and three more in the eighth.

Six different Florida State players had RBI in the game. Ty Mueller, who homered in the third for FSU's fifth run, had two hits and scored four runs. Kevin McCray led the Seminoles with three RBI on two hits.

Davis, who relieved Wilson and John Nedeau in the fourth, allowed only one hit over the next 4.2 innings -- that a solo home run by CSU third baseman Tommy Lark in the eighth. He picked up his fourth win of the year with all four victories coming in relief.

Lark was two-for-four with a pair of RBI for Charleston Southern. Doug Hutto led the Buccaneers with three hits in four trips to the plate. Ken Nelson, Steve Strickland and W.C. Rains also each picked up two hits for Charleston Southern.

The Seminoles play host to Coastal Carolina in a two-game series beginning Friday night at 5:30 p.m. at Howser Stadium.
