Florida State 8, Richmond 2

TALLAHASSEE -- Florida State prepared for its first Atlantic Coast Conference road trip this weekend by completing a three-game sweep of Richmond with an 8-2 victory Wednesday afternoon at Dick Howser Stadium.

A chilly crowd of 849 saw the third-ranked Seminoles raise their record to 18-3 on the year with their eighth straight win. Richmond fell to 2-6 with the loss.

FSU starter John Wasdin pitched out of first inning trouble to get the victory and improve his record to 1-1. Wasdin gave up three hits over five innings and struck out four. FSU head coach Mike Martin used four different hurlers over the final four innings.

The Seminoles went ahead early with three runs in the first. A pair of Richmond errors put the first two batters on base before Chris Roberts' single scored the first FSU run. One hitter later, Brock laced a double down the leftfield line to drive in two.

FSU extended its lead in the third off Richmond starter and loser Craig Saccavino, 0-1. Link Jarrett's RBI single plated Brock. By the end of the fourth inning, the Seminoles held a comfortable 6-1 margin.

Brock and Tony Liebsack led Florida State with two hits apiece. David Harkins collected two hits and scored both Richmond runs to lead the Spiders.

Florida State travels to Chapel Hill, N.C. for a three-game set against ACC rival North Carolina this weekend.
