Florida State 12, N.C. State 1

TALLAHASSEE -- Junior Chris Roberts threw a complete-game four-hitter for his fifth victory of the season and Florida State claimed its fifth straight win with a 12-1 defeat of conference rival North Carolina State.

FSU, ranked third in the nation, raised its record to 24-4 overall, 6-2 in the Atlantic Coast Conference. N.C. State fell to 21-6, 3-5.

Roberts struck out 10, walked two and did not allow an earned run in pitching his fourth complete game of 1992. He raised his record to 5-0 on the season. N.C. State scored its lone run in the sixth. Vinny Hughes, who led the Wolfpack with two hits, singled to score Rob Bark.

Florida State scored four runs in the first two innings to make a loser of NCSU starter Shawn Senior, 4-2. Roberts plated the first run with a sacrifice fly in the first. In the second inning, Link Jarrett's groundout scored John Cook with FSU's second run and with runners on first and third, Florida State's double steal worked to perfection, Justin Rigney sliding home to put Florida State up 3-0. Allen Bevis scored when Nandy Serrano singled up the middle for the first of his two hits on the day.


Wolfpack reliever David Allen entered in the third and held the Seminoles to just one hit over the next five innings. He struck out nine, but left after giving up a single to open the eighth. FSU proceeded to score eight runs in that inning off two more NCSU pitchers. The Seminoles took advantage of three N.C. State errors in the frame.

Serrano was the only Seminole with more than one hit on the day. He and Cook each drove in a pair to lead Florida State.


FSU and N.C. State conclude the three-game series Sunday at 1 p.m. at Dick Howser Stadium.
