TALLAHASSEE--Greg McKinney hit a two-out double in the top of the ninth and scored on Jim Callihan's single as Mercer University upset ninth-ranked Florida State 4-3. The Seminoles, 26-9, lost four straight for the first time since the 1985 season.

Mercer starter Mark Wright threw a complete game to improve his record to 6-1. Wright struck out six, including the side in the bottom of the ninth to secure the win for the Bears (17-9).

FSU took a three-run lead with a run in the second and a pair in the third. Chris Roberts doubled and scored on Ty Mueller's single. Second baseman Tony Liebsack led off the third with a single and stole second. Nandy Serrano drove him in with a double to center.

The Bears countered with two runs in the fourth. Bucky Goff singled in a run, with the other scoring on shortstop Link Jarrett's error. Mercer tied the game in the sixth on Terrell Mitchell's infield single.

Tim Davis came on in the sixth for the Seminoles to relieve starter Paul Wilson. Davis struck out eight but suffered his first loss of the season to drop to 4-1.

Mercer and Florida State conclude the two-game set Thursday at 7:00 p.m. at Howser Stadium.
