TALLAHASSEE--Florida State scored runs in all but two innings and held Mercer to one run on four hits in an 8-1 win Wednesday in collegiate baseball action at Dick Howser Stadium. The win snapped a four game losing streak for the ninth-ranked Seminoles.

The Seminole bats erupted for 13 hits, including seven doubles. Link Jarrett led FSU with a three-for-five performance. The sophomore shortstop had a pair of doubles and RBIs. Tony Liebsack also had a pair of two base hits.

FSU starter John Wasdin upped his record to 3-2, throwing five complete innings. Wasdin surrendered one run on four hits. Bryan Harris relieved Wasdin with four innings of no hit ball. Harris struckout eight in gaining his first save this season.

Doug Kries led Mercer, scoring the sole Bear run. Kries finished the game two-for-two at the plate. Starter Adams Ropp suffered the loss for Mercer. His record dropped to 2-1.

The Seminoles resume play Friday in a three game series with ACC foe Georgia Tech at 7:00 p.m. at Howser Stadium.
