Georgia Tech 10, Florida State 3

TALLAHASSEE--Georgia Tech scored four runs in the top of the sixth to break a 3-3 tie and the Yellow Jackets cruised to a 10-3 win over ninth-ranked Florida State Sunday.

Tech salvaged the final game of the three-game ACC series to improve to 26-7, 5-6. FSU fell to 29-10, 10-7.

Michael Smith led off the sixth with a solo shot over the screen in right. Jay Payton, who had four hits on the afternoon, singled in a pair of runs to chase FSU starter Tim Davis (4-2) with one out in the sixth. Payton doubled in another run in the seventh.

Jason Varitek drove in three runs for Georgia Tech with a two-run double that tied the game in the fifth and a solo home run to lead off the eighth.

Tech reliever Brett Binkley shut out the Seminoles, allowing just four hits in five and a third innings of work. Binkley fanned six and walked just one in running his record to 4-0.

Allen Bevis had three hits for Florida State, who hosts third-ranked Florida Wednesday.
