TALLAHASSEE -- Gino DiMare's double drove in the go ahead run in the sixth and reliever Gus Gandarillas made the lead stick, pitching five scoreless innings as second-ranked Miami beat ninth-ranked Florida State 6-3 Saturday night before 5,945 at Dick Howser Stadium.

Miami (30-5) scored twice after two were out in the sixth to make a loser of FSU starter Chris Roberts (5-2). Juan Llanes singled, went to second on a wild pitch, and scored on a single by Luis Hernandez. DiMare's hit plated Hernandez to give the Hurricanes a 4-3 lead.

Miami added a pair of insurance runs in the ninth off of reliever Paul Wilson.

After Miami picked up two unearned runs in the first inning, Roberts quickly tied the score with a two-run home run to left, his tenth of the year. FSU (30-12) took a 3-2 lead in the fourth when Randy Hodges drew a bases loaded walk off of Miami starter Kenny Henderson, forcing home Kevin McCray.

Gandarillas replaced Henderson with two runners on base and no outs in the fifth, striking out McCray before enticing Link Jarrett to ground into a double play. Gandarillas (4-1) set down the first ten batters he faced. The right hander gave up just two hits and struck out six.

Charles Johnson had three hits and drove in a pair of runs for Miami.
