DAVIS STRIKES OUT CAREER-HIGH 13 AS FSU TAKES SECOND STRAIGHT FROM WAKE For Immediate Release (April 18, 1992)

WINSTON-SALEM -- Tim Davis struck out a career-high 13 and tossed his second straight complete game as Florida State beat Wake Forest for the second day in-a-row with a 9-4 triumph at Hooks Stadium.

Davis (5-3) handcuffed the Deacons on eight hits, and fanned at least one batter in every inning, including the second and third when he struck out the side.

Florida State (32-14, 12-7 ACC) got on the board in the opening inning on a single by Nandy Serrano and a two-out double by Chris Roberts, who finished with three runs batted in on the day. Roberts had a sacrifice fly his next time up to make it a 2-0 lead for FSU, but Ross Restuccio got Wake back in the game with a solo homer leading off the bottom of the third.

The Seminoles stretched their lead to 4-1 in the fourth when Link Jarrett smacked his first career home run, a two-run shot off starter Steve DeFranco (6-4), but the Deacons (25-15, 9-8 ACC) rallied in their half of the inning.

Jake Austin, who stretched his hitting streak to a season-high 15 games, led off with a double. Chris Smith followed with a walk and then Dave Marzano scored Austin with a sacrifice fly. Smith eventually scored on a wild pitch and George Coghill, who singled, came home on a two-out single by Restuccio to make it 4-4.

From that point on, however, the Deacons got only three hits and failed to get

a man past second base as Davis was aided by a pair of double plays.

FSU regained the lead in the seventh as Serrano led off with a double, went to third on a sacrifice by Chris Brock, and scored on Roberts' suicide squeeze. Roberts had to do a jump roping act to get the ball down as the pitch from DeFranco came well inside.

The Seminoles broke the contest open in the eighth as Tony Liebsack, Colby Weaver and Link Jarrett all drove in runs. Jarrett scored the final run of the game when, after his double, he moved to third on a wild pitch and scored on a throwing error by catcher Restuccio.

The three-game series between Wake Forest and Florida State will conclude tomorrow afternoon at Hooks Stadium with the first pitch slated for 1 p.m.


