MIAMI DEFEATS 'NOLES 7-3
...win 14th in a row

CORAL GABLES, FL- Senior lefty Jeff Alkire (9-2) pitched seven strong innings, scattering seven hits and striking out five as the University of Miami (36-5) topped rival Florida State (33-15) 7-3 Friday night at Mark Light Stadium in front of 5,026 fans.

The win was UM's 14th in a row and 23rd in the last 24. The last time the Hurricanes won 14 in a row was 1985 when UM went on to win the national title

UM broke open a 4-3 game in the seventh with three runs, all with two outs. Juan Llanes walked and scored on Gino DiMare's triple to right. DiMare had a big night at the plate going 2-4 with 2 RBI's and two runs scored. Dave Berg drove in DiMare with his third single of the game. He tallied the 'Canes final run on a Johnathen Smith single.

The Seminoles wasted no time in taking a 1-0 lead. Allen Bevis led off the game with a single and scored on a fielder's choice grounder by Chris Brock.

Miami rebounded in the second. After a Smith single, Charles Johnson hit his fifth home run of the year to give the 'Canes a 2-1 advantage.

FSU evened things in the fourth by way of Chris Roberts' eleventh homer of the season.

In the fifth, the 'Noles grabbed a 3-2 lead. John Cook and Bevis singled to lead off the frame. Cook scored the go-ahead run on a Nandy Serrano single.

The Hurricanes took the lead for good in the bottom of the inning. Llanes singled, stole second and scored on a DiMare single. DiMare then stole second and third, his 29th and 30th swipes of the year, and scored on a Berg single.

Florida State starter Tim Davis (5-4) took the loss.

Gus Gandarillas relieved Alkire and pitched the final two innings

The two teams meet again on Saturday at 7:30. Freshman Kenny Henderson (7-1) will face Seminoles' junior Chris Roberts (6-2). The final game of the weekend set is Sunday at 1:30 p.m.
