MIAMI KNOCKS OFF 'NOLES 5-4
...win 15th in a row

CORAL GABLES, FL- Johnnathen Smith tripled with two outs in the ninth and scored on a throwing error by Florida State catcher John Cook after an Alex Miranda strikeout to give the University of Miami Hurricanes (37-5) a 5-4 come-from-behind victory over Florida State University (33-16) Saturday night at Mark Light Stadium in front of 6,290 fans, the second largest crowd of the season. The win was Miami's 15th in a row, and sixth straight against FSU. The Hurricanes have now won five games in their last at-bat and are 9-2 when they strike out at least ten times.

The 6,290 fans in attendance pushed the season total to 104,665, the 13th time in the past 14 years Miami has eclipsed the 100,000 fan mark.

The Hurricanes jumped out to a quick start, as they loaded the bases in the first. Gino DiMare led off with a single, but was erased from the basepath when he was caught stealing. Dave Berg drew a walk and Frank Mora singled him to third. After Johnnathen Smith walked, Charles Johnson drove home Berg with a fielder's choice grounder. After another walk to Kevin DiGiacomo, Seminole catcher Colby Weaver allowed a Chris Roberts pitch to get by, which brought home Mora, and gave Miami a 2-0 lead.

FSU wasted little time in taking the 2-run lead. After a Tony Liebsack single and a walk to Weaver, Kenny Felder stroked a double to right. Dean Crow relieved Hurricane starter Kenny Henderson after only 2-2/3 innings, but allowed back-to-back hits; a double by Roberts, which scored Felder, and a single by Chris Brock that plated Roberts and gave the 'Noles a 4-2 advantage.

Miami drew within 4-3 in the sixth. Miami again loaded the bases by way of a Smith single, Johnson walk and a hit batter, Kevin DiGiacomo. Chad Rupp then delivered a single to score Smith.

The 'Canes tied the game at 4-4 in the eighth. DiGiacomo doubled to lead off the frame. Greg Coleman came on to run and went to third on a ground out by Juan Llanes. Chad Hoelker then drove in Coleman with a fielder's choice grounder.

Hurricane reliever Danny Graves (2-0) threw three innings of relief to earn his second career win.

Florida State starter Chris Roberts went eight innings, scattered seven hits and struck out eleven. He also threw 174 pitches in the no-decision, as FSU reliever John Wasdin (3-3) suffered the loss in relief.

The two teams complete the weekend series on Sunday at 1:30. Sophomore Silvio Censale (8-0) will face Seminoles' junior Roger Bailey (10-3).
