Florida State 15, Maryland 3

TALLAHASSEE -- Kenny Felder went 5-for-5 with a pair of doubles and Nandy Serrano drove in four runs with two hits, including a three-run homer, to lead Florida State to a 15-3 victory over Maryland Saturday night in Atlantic Coast Conference baseball action.

The victory improved FSU's record to 36-16 overall, 15-7 in the ACC, and clinched second place in the conference race for the Seminoles. Florida State will receive a bye in the first round of the conference tournament, which begins next Saturday in Greenville, S.C.

Maryland fell to 24-25-1, 7-14 with the loss.

Terp starter John Rayne (4-3) gave up six runs in the first two innings as the Seminoles gained an early lead and cruised to the win. Chris Roberts' two-run double was the big blow in the first, while Serrano hit his three-run homer, his fifth of the season, in the second.

Florida State starter Tim Davis (6-4) saw the Terps score twice in the second on back-to-back doubles by Chris Smoot and Ken Noe, and a single by Matt Bailey. But that was all he allowed in six innings of work. Davis gave up four hits and struck out eight in the contest.

Six Seminoles had at least two rbi in the game as Florida State's 18 hits included six doubles and a pair of home runs. Bailey and Derek Hacopian led Maryland with two hits apiece. Hacopian blasted his school-record tying 19th home run in the eighth for Maryland's final run.

The two teams complete the three-game series Sunday at 2 p.m.
