FLORIDA STATE 8, APPALACHIAN STATE 3

TALLAHASSEE, FL--Freshman Doug Mientkiewicz' three-run, fifth inning double sparked a six-run rally that lifted 10th-ranked Florida State to an 8-3 win over Appalachian State before 1,111 at Dick Howser Stadium.

Righthander John Wasdin (1-0) picked up the win, fanning eight in six innings of work. Wasdin gave up just three hits, including a three-run, home run by ASU leftfielder Johnny McGraw in the third inning that staked the Mountaineers to a 3-0 lead.

Grady Jordan led off the bottom of the third with a triple and scored on a sacrifice fly by Link Jarrett. In the fourth, Randy Hodges doubled in Mike Martin to cut the ASU lead to 3-2.

Jordan, Jarrett and Ty Mueller greeted ASU reliever Dave Gonsiorowski (0-1) with consecutive singles to open the fifth inning, setting the stage for Mientkiewicz, who drilled a double into the gap in right center to clear the bases. Off to a fast start, Mientkiewicz has driven in seven runs on five hits in his first three games as a Seminole.

Hodges and Jordan had two hits for Florida State (3-0), and Hodges drove in a pair of runs.

Appalachian State loaded the bases in the sixth and eighth innings, but Florida State got out of both frames unscathed.

FSU and Appalachian State meet again Wednesday at Howser Stadium at 3:30 p.m.
