Florida State 7, College of Charleston 6

TALLAHASSEE -- Ty Mueller's bases-loaded single scored Link Jarrett with the winning run in the bottom of the ninth, capping a two-run rally that lifted 10th-ranked Florida State to a 7-6 win over the College of Charleston Friday afternoon at Dick Howser Stadium.

The Seminoles, 5-0, were forced to come from behind after the Cougars took the lead with four runs in the top of the ninth.

Freshman Scott Schroeffel led off the home half of the ninth with a bunt single. Link Jarrett drew a walk and Kevin McCray reached when Charleston reliever Sam Moore fielded his sacrifice bunt and tried to force Schroeffel, who beat the throw at third. Mike Schmitz drew a walk to force in Schroeffel with the tying run, and Mueller slapped a single up the middle to score Jarrett with the game winner.

Charleston's rally came with two outs and the bases empty. Shawn Lopez singled, Adam Brown reached on an error, and Benji Kennedy kept the Cougars alive with an infield hit.

Brett Fillaw lined a single to center to plate Lopez and pinch runner Jimmy Granger, cutting the Florida State lead to 5-4 and chasing reliever Steven Morgan, who opened the ninth with a pair of strikeouts.

Phil Olson relieved Morgan and uncorked a wild pitch, scoring pinch runner Richard Fraschure with the tying run. R.J. Kackley singled in Fallaw to give Charleston a 6-5 lead.

Florida State had scored four runs in the sixth to take a 5-1 lead. Doug Mientkiewicz and Schmitz, whose solo homer tied the game at 1-1 in the fourth, led off the inning with consecutive singles. Mike Martin doubled home Mientkiewicz, and Schmitz came home on a wild pitch. Randy Hodges singled in Martin, and scored on a squeeze bunt by Chad Sheffer.

FSU and Charleston meet again Saturday at 1 p.m. and complete the three-game set Sunday at 2 p.m.
