Florida State 3, Cal-State Fullerton 2

TALLAHASSEE -- Florida State scored three runs in the first three innings and a trio of FSU pitchers held off Cal-State Fullerton to give the Seminoles a 3-2 victory in college baseball action Friday.

FSU ran its winning streak to eight straight games with the win over sixth-ranked Cal-State Fullerton. The Seminoles' 8-0 start marks its best record since a 12-0 run to start the 1985 season. Fullerton dropped to 4-4 with the loss.

Florida State scored two runs in the first on three straight singles, a walk and a sacrifice fly. Doug Mientkiewicz singled in Randy Hodges with the game's first run, extending his hitting streak to eight games. The freshman also had a seventh-inning double and scored FSU's third run of the game in the third. Mike Martin picked up Florida State's second RBI in the first with a sacrifice fly to score Link Jarrett.

FSU took advantage of wildness by CSUF starter and loser Dan Ricabal (2-1) in the third for its final run. Ricabal walked four men in the inning with a free pass to Chad Sheffer plating Mientkiewicz.

Then it was up to FSU pitchers Paul Wilson, Jonathan Johnson and Phil Olson to shut down the Titans, last year's national champion runner-up. Wilson pitched a one-hitter through the first five innings before tiring in the sixth. He got the win to improve his record to 3-0 on the year.

In the sixth, CSUF scored twice on four singles with Adam Millan and Jim Betzsold driving in the runs. With two outs and the bases loaded, Johnson relieved Wilson and struck out D.C. Olson to end the threat. Olson came on with one out and one on in the ninth and struck out the final two hitters to earn his third save.

FSU's pitchers combined for 10 strikeouts and did not allow an extra base hit in the game.

The two teams continue the three-game series Saturday at Noon at Dick Howser Stadium.
