Cal State-Fullerton 13, Florida State 6

TALLAHASSEE -- Sixth-ranked Cal State-Fullerton scored seven runs with two outs in the top of the ninth inning to break a 6-6 tie and claim a 13-6 victory over eighth-ranked Florida State in college baseball action Sunday.

Scott Allen, who had not batted all season, laid down a bunt with the bases loaded to score Dante Powell with the winning run. Fullerton's Kyle Evans followed with a single to drive in two more runs and the floodgates opened.

FSU reliever Phil Olson, 1-1, started the ninth and quickly recorded the first two outs before Powell started the CSUF rally with a single. Tony Banks then walked, and Adam Millan's infield hit loaded the bases to set up Allen's heroics.

Florida State had tied the game at six in the eighth by scoring four runs. Randy Hodges opened the inning with a solo home run. Two hits and three walks later, Scott Schroeffel's sacrifice fly scored Mike Martin with the tying run for FSU.

The game was a 1-1 pitcher's duel through six innings as Florida State's John Wasdin and Fullerton's Jon Ward allowed only a handful of hits.

Florida State scored first on a double by Mickey Lopez, who eventually scored on a ground out by Chad Sheffer.

CSUF tied the game in the fourth when Banks led off the inning with a home run. Fullerton took a 4-1 lead in the seventh and expanded it to 6-2 in the eighth.

The two teams combined to score 17 of their 19 runs in the final three innings. Cal State Fullerton banged out 15 hits off five FSU pitchers. Powell led the way for the Titans with three singles while shortstop Nate Rodriguez drove in three runs with a pair of hits.

Lopez led Florida State, collecting two of FSU's five hits, including a double and a triple.

Kimson Hollibaugh, 1-2, the fourth pitcher of the day for Cal State Fullerton, picked up the win. The Titans improved to 6-4 while Florida State fell to 8-2.

FSU plays host to intra-state rival Florida for two games beginning Thursday at 7 p.m. at Dick Howser Stadium.
