Purdue 11, Florida State 1

DAYTONA BEACH, FLA. -- Purdue pitcher Jason Smith threw a complete-game seven-hitter and struck out 10 to lead the Boilermakers to an 11-1 victory over Florida State in college baseball action at Jackie Robinson Stadium in Daytona Beach Thursday.

The loss broke a five-game FSU winning streak and dropped the Seminoles' record to 13-3 on the season. Purdue improved to 5-2.

Smith struck out 10 and walked four while mastering the Florida State hitters. He allowed only one hit in the first four innings and only three through the first seven. No Florida State runner reached third base until the eighth.

FSU starting pitcher Charlie Cruz lasted only a third of an inning in his first career start. He was lifted for Jeff Tam after loading the bases in the first. Tam got out of the jam and pitched a perfect second inning before Purdue scored its first run in the third. Jermaine Allensworth, who had walked, eventually scored on a Tam wild pitch.

The Boilermakers took a 4-0 lead in the fifth. With one out, Allensworth, who went 3-for-4 in the game, hit a solo home run. After a single by Mike Biltimier, catcher Scott Barrett blasted a two-run homer. It was the first of two home runs on the day for Barrett, who went 4-for-5 with three runs batted in in the game.

Florida State used four pitchers in the sixth inning, when Purdue scored five runs to salt the game away. After Danny Kanell, who had relieved Tam in the fifth, loaded the bases, Phil Olson entered and gave up a bloop single to Dan Zandola to score two. A walk reloaded the bases for Kanell, who returned to the mound and surrendered a three-run double to Biltimier.

Centerfielder Scott Schroeffel pitched the final three innings for FSU. He and Mike Martin went 2-for-4 at the plate to lead the Seminoles offensively. FSU scored its only run in the eighth, Martin's single driving in Mike Schmitz. Tam, 0-1, took the loss.

Florida State opens its Atlantic Coast Conference schedule Friday with a 5 p.m. game against North Carolina at Dick Howser Stadium. Paul Wilson (4-0) will start for FSU.
