North Carolina State 4, Florida State 1

RALEIGH, N.C. -- Florida State concluded a 3-3 spring break road trip by falling 4-1 to North Carolina State Sunday at Doak Field in Raleigh. With the victory, seventh-ranked N.C. State claimed the three-game season series and upped its record to 25-3, 6-1 in the Atlantic Coast Conference. Fifth-ranked Florida State dropped to 24-6, 8-3.

N.C. State pitcher Tommy Sports allowed six hits, but just one run until he was relieved by David Allen in the seventh. Sports improved his record to 4-1 on the year, while Allen notched his eighth save.

FSU starter John Wasdin ran into trouble in the third inning, when the Wolfpack scored three. The first three NCSU hitters in the inning reached to load the bases. After Andy Barkett grounded into a double play to score N.C. State's first run, Tim Tracey and Pat Clougherty each collected RBI hits. Wasdin's record fell to 5-1 with the loss.

Florida State had taken a 1-0 lead in the top of the third on Doug Mientkiewicz' sacrifice fly, but the Seminoles were shut out the rest of the game.

Clougherty, Barkett and Kevin Carswell collected two hits apiece to lead the Wolfpack. Shortstop Link Jarrett was the only Seminole with two hits.

FSU returns to action in Tallahassee Tuesday at 7 p.m. for the first of two games against the Mercer Bears.
