Wake Forest 4, Florida State 1

TALLAHASSEE -- Wake Forest pitchers Marc Palmieri and Bret Wagner combined on a three-hitter and catcher Kyle Wagner collected three hits, including the game-winner in the eighth, to give the Demon Deacons a 4-1 victory over second-ranked Florida State in Atlantic Coast Conference baseball action Friday.

Wake Forest's win was its first over Florida State since 1967 and snapped FSU's six-game winning streak. The Seminoles suffered their first home loss in 16 games and fell to 31-8 overall, 10-5 in the ACC. Wake Forest improved to 23-11, 7-7.

Palmieri, 6-2, held the Seminoles hitless through the first five innings before Mike Martin's double scored Doug Mientkiewicz in the sixth to give FSU a 1-0 lead. Palmieri struck out six and did not walk a batter before giving way to Bret Wagner in the eighth. Wagner pitched the final two innings to earn his seventh save of the year.

Wake Forest left men in scoring position in five of the first six innings before tying the score at one in the seventh. Kyle Wagner singled and scored on an infield grounder by David Hedgecoe.

The Demon Deacons took a 2-1 lead in the eighth off FSU starter and loser Paul Wilson, 8-3. Steve DeFranco, who had two hits on the day, singled and went all the way to third when Scott Schroeffel's throw back to the infield went into the FSU dugout. One batter later, DeFranco scored on Kyle Wagner's third hit of the day.

WFU added a pair of insurance runs in the ninth on a two-out, two-RBI single by DeFranco. Three of Wake Forest's four runs on the day were unearned as the Seminoles committed four errors.

The two teams continue the three-game series Saturday night at 7 p.m. at Dick Howser Stadium.
