Florida State 6, Wake Forest 0

TALLAHASSEE -- A pair of freshmen, pitcher Jonathan Johnson and first baseman Doug Mientkiewicz, combined to lead second-ranked Florida State to a 6-0 victory over Wake Forest in Atlantic Coast Conference baseball action Saturday night.

Johnson, a righthander from Ocala, Fla., improved his record to 7-0 with eight shutout innings. He struck out 11 and walked four while scattering seven hits. Johnson's earned run average over his last five starts is 0.83. Freshman reliever Phil Olson pitched the ninth to complete the shutout.

Mientkiewicz powered the Seminole offense by driving in four runs with a home run and a double. His three-run home run in the third inning gave Florida State a 5-0 cushion. The Miami product also stroked a double in the fifth to bring in FSU's last run.

Florida State scored twice in the second off losing pitcher Jason Robbins, 4-2, on consecutive singles by Mike Schmitz, Mickey Lopez and Randy Hodges, and a successful double steal attempt. Mientkiewicz' homer in the third came after Grady Jordan reached on a bunt and Link Jarrett was hit by a pitch.

David Hedgecoe picked up two of Wake Forest's seven hits to lead the Demon Deacons offensively.

Florida State improved to 32-8 on the year, 11-5 in the ACC while Wake Forest fell to 23-12, 7-8. The two teams complete the three-game series Sunday at 2 p.m. at Dick Howser Stadium after splitting the first two games.
